

Photographic Organisations

- **Photographic Alliance of Great Britain (PAGB)** co-ordinates photographic clubs in England, Scotland, Wales & Northern Ireland. It does this through 15 geographical regions known as Federations. The PAGB organises national competitive events for its Federations and awards for photographic merit. The PAGB is a member of the International Federation of Photographic Art (FIAP). There are currently approximately 980 clubs in the PAGB.
- **Chiltern Association of Camera Clubs (CACC)** is an association of 50 clubs in the Chilterns and Thames Valley region of the UK and is affiliated to the PAGB

External Photographic Competitions

Photographic Alliance of Great Britain (PAGB):

- **PAGB Inter-Club Print Championship**
An annual inter-federation print competition hosted by the PAGB at Connah's Quay. Each club submits prints for selection to represent their federation. The competition consists of two rounds, the first of which must be selected and notified in advance of the competition.
- **PAGB Colour Slide National Championship**
Two clubs represent each regional photographic Federation. Held annually at the University of Warwick.

Chiltern Association of Camera Clubs (CACC):

- **CACC Inter-Club Slide Championship (The 'Rosebowl')**
A slide competition hosted by the CACC, comprising 40 clubs in a league system knockout competition over 3 rounds. The final of the Rosebowl Competition is held on the same day as the CACC Best Club Panel of Prints and Audio-Visual competitions
- **CACC Inter-Club Slide Competition**
An annual competition open to all clubs in the CACC. The winning clubs represent the Chilterns in the annual PAGB Colour Slide National Championship at Warwick. The CACC Inter-Club Print and Slide Championships are held on the same day. This competition superseded the Wycombe trophy in 2004.
- **CACC Inter-Club Print Championship**
An annual competition open to all clubs in the CACC. The winner and runner-up represent the Chilterns in the annual PAGB Inter-Club Print Championship at Connah's Quay. The CACC Inter-Club Print and Slide Championships are held on the same day.
- **CACC Best Club Panel of Six Prints Trophy**
A 'panel of prints' competition run by the CACC on the same day as the Rosebowl Finals.

Guildhall Print Competition:

- A friendly print competition between seven clubs. Hosted by High Wycombe Camera Club.

Federation of North West London Photographic Societies:

- Hosts of an annual knockout print and slide competition, over 3 rounds, between 12 clubs (from North-West London)

Previsions:

- Pre-Visions is an annual print and slide competition amongst 20 clubs Hosted by the XRR Photographic Society of Garston
