## Members' Galleries images:

All APS members are invited and welcome to submit images for their individual gallery on the Members' Galleries page of the web site.

These galleries are a great way for members to show their own images to the public and also to demonstrate the breadth & depth of the talent within APS.

Members can submit up to 8 images of their choice - they're not vetted at all.

The requirements for the images are:

- We will take up to 8 images from each person.
- We won't show letters after your name as long names upset the appearance of the page.
- Filenames will appear as captions. So:
  - Their filenames (without 'jpg') will be the titles appearing in the gallery.
     (I'll retype the file names to make a decent caption)
  - If you want the images to appear in a specific order, then start the filename with the number of the thumbnail position that you want, e.g. 1spitting cobra.jpg.
    Images will appear in numerical or alphabetical order left-to-right.
- They will be put onto the web site without further alteration if they are :
  - ❖ JPEG
  - Not more than 600 pixels wide nor 400 pixels tall.
  - ❖ 72 pixels/inch resolution (Otherwise they don't display properly I don't know why)
  - ❖ Each file size is less than 150 kb.
  - Saved in the sRGB colour space.
     Monochrome images can be in sRGB or greyscale.
     Adobe RGB is not suitable for web images they'll look dull.
- If they are not as we need, I will either return them to you, or modify them before putting them into the gallery.
- E-mail the images as attachments, directly to me, at <a href="mailto:btmike.hynes@btinternet.com">btmike.hynes@btinternet.com</a> and I'll put them up as soon as I am able.
- Usually, one image from each gallery appears in the APS Home Page slideshow.
- Gallery images need to be refreshed after 12 months and will be deleted after 18 months.
