As in previous years the exhibition will be held at the superb venue of St Michael's Church on Sycamore Road, Amersham between the 22nd and 27th August with the Monday evening being reserved to erect the exhibition.

The exhibition will be open from 10-00am to 6pm daily. It is anticipated there will be an exclusive evening for Member's on either the Thursday or Friday evening.

There is still plenty of time to consider which images you would wish to exhibit, or indeed, to go out and take some fresh pictures. The Jubilee holiday is an ideal motivator to add to your portfolio.

Do remember this is for all members to exhibit their work, go on, produce some work, it is highly likely that it is of a greater quality than you might imagine.

Can I request that you do take a few minutes to look at the rules for the exhibition, it avoids potential disappointment to the exhibitor if the print does not meet the criteria for display and is subsequently unable to be shown.

As a reminder to established members and as a plea to new members, without stewards for the exhibition it will not be possible for it to take place. Ideally, I need 4 stewards per session. It is not an onerous task and tea and coffee (possibly biscuits!) are provided.
