

APS Members' Galleries images:

All members are welcome to submit images for their individual gallery on the Members' Galleries page of the web site. These galleries are a great way for members to show their images to the public and also to demonstrate the breadth of talent within APS. Members can submit up to 8 images of their choice – they're not vetted.

The requirements are:

- Up to 8 images from each person.
- Same as PDI entries – JPEGs, not more than 1600 pixels wide nor 1200 pixels tall. 600x400 px is still acceptable; you may prefer this lower resolution to deter copying.
- Filenames will appear as captions (without .jpg). I'll punctuate them if necessary. If you want the images to appear in a specific order left-to-right, then start the filenames with the number of the position that you want, e.g. 1spitting cobra.jpg)
- Save files in the sRGB colour space. Monochrome images can be in sRGB or greyscale. Adobe RGB is not suitable for web images – they'll look dull.
- If they are not as we need, I will either return them to you, or modify them before putting them into the gallery.
- E-mail the images as attachments, to me, at web@amershamphotosoc.com and I'll put them up as soon as I am able.
- One image from each gallery will usually appear in the APS Home Page slideshow.
- Gallery images need to be refreshed after 12 months. After 18 months they will be deleted.
- Contact me if you have any queries or need help.
